The road straight North to Ethiopia has allowed us to discover the impressive Samburu people with pearl ornaments and cross the first arid area since Namibia.

Ethiopia is a striking country due to its rich history (the only African country which has never been colonized) and culture (coffee, having fun with friends), as well as its social and religious diversity. We liked the atmosphere in Addis Ababa where we felt safe. We have been found back Lada cars since Ethiopia has been communist for 15 years. We must regularly slalom between huge herds of cattle on the road (cows, sheep, goats, camels).
